HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

As Managing Director of Contract Furniture (UK) Ltd., I have overall responsibility for the health and safety of our employees, as well as our customers and members of the public who may be affected by our work. So that this responsibility can be exercised effectively, I have authorized the publication of this Health and Safety Policy, which sets out safety principles and standards as well as a managerial framework.

Health and Safety are managerial responsibilities which rank equally with all other responsibilities that our managers have and it is their duty to see that everything reasonably possible is done to prevent injury or loss in the processes of carrying out the duties prescribed to them.

We will take all reasonably practicable steps to prevent injury to personnel or damage to property and eliminate hazards, which could lead to such accidents.

In accordance with the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulation 1992 Contract Furniture (UK) Ltd will adopt a risk assessment approach to its activities.

We recognise that it is necessary to train people to work safely and will ensure that all our people are adequately qualified.

We will make arrangements to ensure that any exposure of our people to chemical, physical and biological agents is monitored and controlled to below legislative limits.

All incidents with the potential to create a reportable injury or incident will be investigated to identify ways to prevent recurrence.

We will continually monitor our performance against these principals and standards and will ensure that a report on health and safety is presented to the directors on a quarterly basis.

Specialist health and safety advice is available from outside agencies. Which will be used for specific projects.
